INFANT BAPTISM

(Infant to 6 Yrs. Old)

FIRST EUCHARIST/RECONCILIATION

(High School to Adult)

1.) HIGH SCHOOL First Eucharist/Confirmation (9th-12th Grade)

Baptized High School students who have not yet received First Eucharist will concurrently be prepared for both First Eucharist and Confirmation. Must enroll in High School Confirmation. (See High School Confirmation)

One or two evenings per month ***in addition to*** Confirmation sessions held two Sundays per month, 3:30 PM to 5:45 PM, (Sept-May). **Parent Meeting on Sunday, Sept. 9th and first session for both student and parents is Sunday, Sept. 23rd. Copy of Baptism Certificate and minimum \$50 deposit due by Parent Meeting.**
